Did you know...

that over three quarters of all doctor visits deal with some form of fear and stress? It turns out that fear has the greatest impact on our lives. All you have to do is look at your television or internet. As we get



older we're being steadily convinced that we need every pill being pedaled. On top of that they then take 75% of the commercial to tell you how this pill can kill you. I think it's meant

to confuse us. Luckily there's a pill for that too! What do you fear? Or what are you anxious about? Your future? Your job? Your singleness? A relationship? Finances? Your appearance? Your reputation? Your health? Your age? Life after death?

I guess everyone feels afraid sometimes. We seem to live in a world surrounded by fear. We understand that an unhealthy fear can become a disruptive part of our lives. We are constantly having to live with anxiety. Out of all the questions posed here, the most anxiety-riddled one is, "Is there life after death?" It is reffered to as the Eternal Question. The answer to that question depends solely on your relationship with the Father through His Son Jesus. You no longer have to fear any longer. It starts with a simple prayer...

"Dear Jesus, I know as a sinner I will be forever separated from you for eternity in a place called Hell. I now understand that you paid for my sins so that through Your sacrifice I no longer have to go there. I believe that you died on the cross for my sins, were buried, and were then resurrected after three days to prove that you indeed are God. You ascended into heaven and now sit at the right hand of the Father. You said, "I am the way and the truth and the life and no man can come to the Father except by me." I now put all my trust in you alone for my salvation. Thank you for loving me enough to die for me.

Dear heavenly Father I come to you in Jesus' name to dispell fear and discouragement in my life.
